XF12-001 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The MORryde X-Factor Crossmember kit is designed to provide added strength and reinforcement to trailer frames. The crossmember can be installed onto a single spring hanger, or for added strength and reinforcement, onto all the spring hangers on the frame. The installation instructions for the kit are detailed below.

Please note: There are specific installation instructions for trailers equipped with a MORryde LRE suspension system. Contact MORryde Parts at 574.293.1581 or email parts@morryde.com.

NOTE

The Standard X-Factor Crossmember kit comes with either:

- > Two 9/16 7/16-20 x 3.4" Wet Bolts and Flange Locknuts OR
- > Two 9/16 1/2-20 x 3.4" Wet Bolts and Flange Locknuts
- > The 9/16-7/16-20 x 3.4" requires an 11/16" socket to tighten to 40 ft-lbs OR
- > 9/16 1/2-20 x 3.4" requires a 3/4" socket to tighten to 80 ft-lbs

XF12-001 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLATION

STEP 1

Support the frame with jacks on each frame rail. Support the axles with floor jacks. While not the easiest method, you can lift and work on one side at a time if needed.

NOTE

If you are installing the crossmember at the equalizer, it is not necessary to remove the tires as the center bolt can be easily accessed from between the wheels. However, if you are installing the crossmember at the end hangers with the leaf spring, remove the tires to access the hanger bolts.

STEP 2

Remove the shoulder bolt from the frame hanger and replace it with one 9/16" wet bolt (shoulder bolt with a grease zerk) included in the installation kit. The bolt should point toward the inside of the trailer, and the exit hole for the grease should point to a 3 or 9 o'clock position. Use a hammer to tap the wet bolt into the frame hanger. Use a small diameter socket to fit over the grease zerk and tap the bolt in place or remove the zerk, tap the bolt in place, and reinstall the zerk. Do not install the nut until the next step (it is important not to damage the grease zerk).





STEP 3

Install the Outer Hanger Bracket Adapter on the trailer frame hanger. Slide one Spacer over the end of the 9/16" wet bolt and thread the 7/16" or 1/2" flange nut on by hand. Do not tighten the nut yet.

Insert two 5/16" flange bolts through the ears of the Outer Hanger Bracket Adapter. Slide a Spacer Tube over each the bolt. Next, slide one Hanger Bracket Plate over the ends of the bolts on the outside of the frame hanger and install the 5/16" flange nuts. Do not tighten yet.

Torque the 7/16" flange nut on the 9/16" wet bolt to 40 ft-lbs (or the 1/2" nut to 80 ft-lbs) with an 11/16" (or 3/4") socket while using a 13/16" wrench to hold the bolt in position. Torque the 5/16" flange nuts evenly on each side of the hanger to 20 ft-lbs with a 1/2" socket and wrench.



STEP 4

Install the X-Factor Outer Channel onto the Outer Hanger Bracket Adapter using (6) 3/8" flange bolts and 3/8" flange nuts. Hand tighten, but do not torque yet.



STEP 5

Repeat Steps 2 - 4 for the opposite side with the Inner Hanger Bracket Adapter, X-Factor Inner Channel, and (2) Spacer Tubes.

STEP 6

Line up the holes on both crossmember channels, and insert (4) 3/8" flange bolts on each side, utilizing the holes farthest from the center in both the top and bottom rows. Install the 3/8" flange nuts.



STEP 7

Torque all 3/8" hardware from the previous steps to 40 ft-lbs with a 9/16" socket and wrench.



STEP 8

Reinstall tires, if necessary, and torque lug nuts to recommended specifications. Remove the jacks and supports from the frame and axle.

INSTALLATION

NOTE

Because the shoulder bolt will not be removed, this installation can be completed without lifting the trailer. However, lifting the trailer will make it easier to maneuver underneath it. If you decide to lift the trailer, support the frame with jacks on each frame rail. You can also lift and work on one side at a time, if needed.

Only the X-Factor Inner and Outer Channels, (8) 3/8" flange nuts and (8) 3/8-16 x 1 flange bolts from the XF12-001 kit will be used – set everthing else aside.

STEP 1

Install (2) Correct Track Adapters on the roadside frame hanger of the trailer using (3) $3/8-16 \times 4 \frac{1}{4}$ bolts.

Tighten the 3/8" flange nuts more than hand tight, but do not yet torque as you will still need to be able to adjust them.

NOTE

To prevent interference of the flange nuts, the head of the innermost bolt must be installed on the opposite adapter as the outer two bolts.



STEP 2

Install the X-Factor Outer Channel onto the (2) Correct Track Adapters on the roadside using (6) 3/8-16 x 1 ¹/₄ bolts and 3/8" flange nuts. Hand tighten, but do not yet torque.





STEP 3

Repeat Steps 1 and 2 for the curbside of the trailer with the remianing (2) Correct Track Adapters, X-Factor Inner Channel, and (3) $3/8-16 \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ bolts. Install the (2) Spacer Plates between the Inner Channel and the (2) Correct Track Adapters to obtain the proper distance between the parts.



STEP 4

Line up the holes on both crossmember channels, and insert (4) 3/8" flange bolts on each side, utilizing the holes farthest from the center in both the top and bottom rows. Install the 3/8" flange nuts.



STEP 5

Torque all hardware from the previous steps to 40 ft-lbs using a 9/16" socket and wrench.



STEP 6

Remove the jacks and supports from the frame and axle.

INSTALLATION

NOTE

Set aside the Inner and Outer Hanger Bracket Adapters from the XF12-001 kit. These will not be used in this installation - they are replaced by the Drop-Down Inner and Outer Hanger Bracket Adapters from the XF12-003 kit.

STEP 1

Support the frame with jacks on each frame rail. Support the axles with floor jacks. While not the easiest method, you can lift and work on one side at a time, if needed.

NOTE

If you are installing the crossmember at the equalizer, it is not necessary to remove the tires as the center bolt can be easily accessed from between the wheels. However, if you are installing the crossmember at the end hangers with the leaf spring, remove the tires to access the hanger bolts.

STEP 2

Remove the shoulder bolt from the frame hanger and replace it with (1) 9/16" wet bolt (shoulder bolt with a grease zerk) included in the XF12-001 installation kit.

The bolt should point toward the inside of the trailer, and the exit hole for the grease should point to the 3 or 9 o'clock position. Use a hammer to tap the wet bolt into the frame hanger. Use a small diameter socket to fit over the grease zerk and tap the bolt in place or remove the zerk, tap the bolt in place, and reinstall the zerk. Do not install the nut until the next step (it is important not to damage the grease zerk).





STEP 3

Install the Drop-Down Outer Hanger Bracket Adapter on the trailer frame hanger. Slide (1) Spacer over the end of the 9/16" wet bolt and thread the 7/16" or 1/2" flange nut on by hand. Do not tighten the nut yet.

Insert (2) 5/16" flange bolts through the ears of the Drop-Down Outer Hanger Bracket Adapter. Slide a Spacer Tube over each of the bolts. Next, slide one Hanger Bracket Plate over the ends of each of the bolts on the outside of the frame hanger and install the 5/16" flange nuts. Do not tighten yet.

NOTE

Torque the 7/16" flange nut on the 9/16" wet bolt to 40 ft-lbs with an 11/16" socket while using a 13/16" wrench to hold the bolt in position. Torque the 5/16" flange nuts evenly on each side of the hanger to 20 ft-lbs with a 1/2" socket and wrench.

NOTE

Torque the 1/2" flange nut on the 9/16" wet bolt to 80 ft-lbs with an 3/4" socket while using a 13/16" wrench to hold the bolt in position. Torque the 5/16" flange nuts evenly on each side of the hanger to 20 ft-lbs with a 1/2" socket and wrench.



STEP 4

Install the X-Factor Outer Channel onto the Drop-Down Outer Hanger Bracket Adapter using (6) 3/8" flange bolts and 3/8" flange nuts. Hand tighten, but do not torque yet.



STEP 5

Repeat Steps 2 - 4 for the opposite side with the Drop-Down Inner Hanger Bracket Adapter, X-Factor Inner Channel.

STEP 6

Line up the holes on both crossmember channels and insert (4) 3/8" flange bolts on each side, utilizing the holes farthest from the center in both the top and bottom rows. Install the 3/8" flange nuts.



STEP 7

Torque all 3/8" hardware from the previous steps to 40 ft-lbs with a 9/16" socket and wrench.



STEP 8

Reinstall tires, if necessary, and torque lug nuts to recommended specifications. Remove the jacks and supports from the frame and axle.
